Warm up

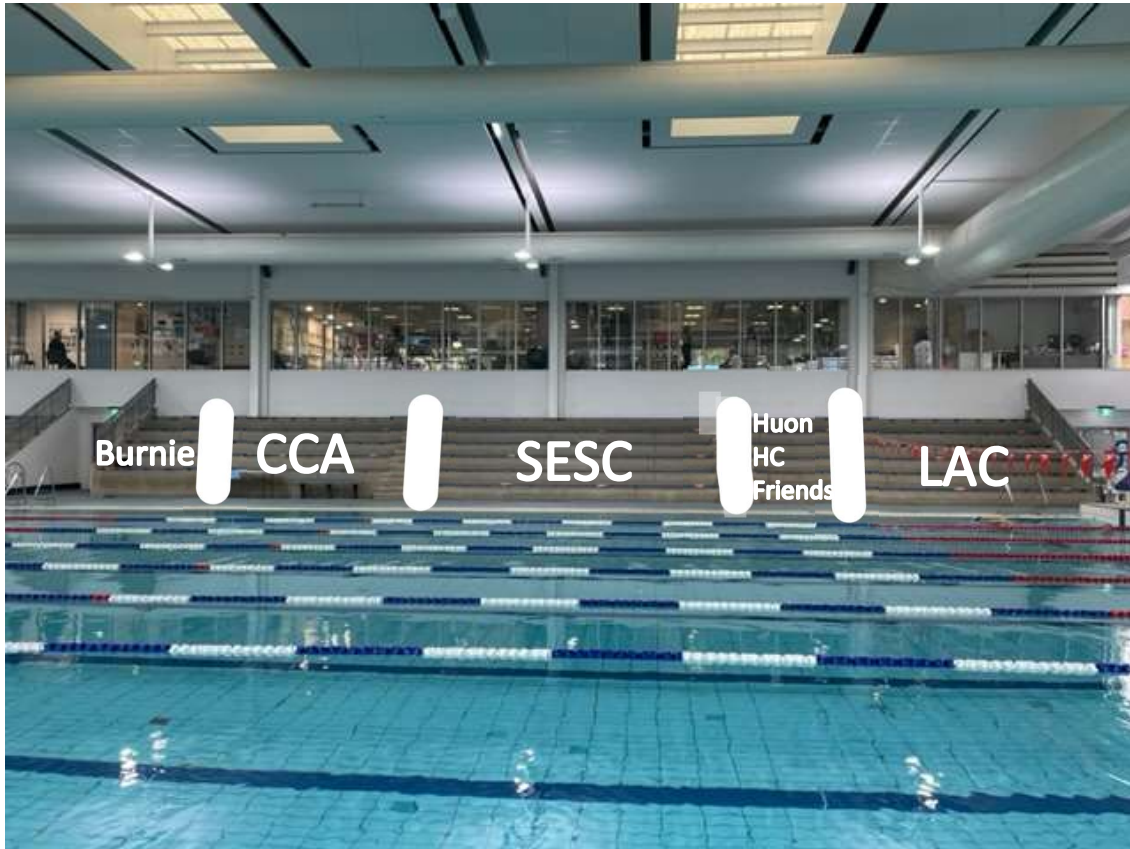

Warm up Cool/Down Lanes

Two lanes have been hired for the duration of the event in the shallow end of the pool (lanes 1 and 2). Please be mindful that other lanes will be used in the shallow end by public swimmers so please do not allow swimmers to use those public lanes to warm up/cool down or play.

Seating Plan

A seating plan has been prepared calculating the numbers of swimmers entered by each club. Spectator will be able to sit in the stand at the shallow end of the pool.



Bather Rule

Normal race suit regulations apply due to individual age group medals. 11< not permitted to wear race suits.

Medal Table

To ensure the meet runs on time there will be a medal collection table and no podium for this event. Medals to be collected by swimmers or team managers. They will be announced when available for collection.

Competition area

Only swimmers, coaches, team leaders, officials and parents whilst performing a rostered duty are allowed to enter and or remain on pool deck in the competition area. The area on the non-grand stand side of the pool is reserved for officials and race sponsors. This area along with the bench seat behind the starting blocks are not available for spectator seating.

Marshalling

Please ensure that swimmers do not go to Marshalling prior to their event being displayed on the marshalling board. Due to the confined area we have limits of the number of persons in this area at any one time. Please note that relay teams will remain with team leaders on pool deck until called to marshal in the top corner of the competition area to allow greater team spirit.

Dash for Cash

During the session break a list of Dash for Cash finalists will be prepared and provided to Team Leaders as soon as possible to enable clubs to have their swimmers ready for the start of the next session. The cash will be presented to the Dash for Cash swimmers immediately after the race has concluded can you please make your swimmers aware. We will allow 20 minutes in the programme for this event and the presentation of prize money.

Relays

For those clubs that do not have enough individual swimmers to enter the Curran Cup and/or age relays, please feel free to collaborate with other clubs on the day to put teams together. Provided there is lane availability in the events we will take exhibition only relay entries at no cost on the day. Please note as these teams are exhibition only they will not be eligible for medals. We will come around during warm up and discuss any additional entries with team leaders.
